

# Concerning those who overcome the Beast, and Dragon, and Whore, and False Prophet.

Rev 11:7. 'The beast shall overcome the two witnesses of God, and kill them.'  
Rev 13:7. 'And the beast shall make war with the saints, and overcome them.'  
Rev 17:14. 'But the lamb shall overcome the beast and his followers.'

Rev 3:21. And Christ said 'To him that overcomes will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne.'

Rev 12:11. 'And the saints overcame the dragon by the blood of the lamb, and the word of their testimony, and they loved not their lives to the death.'

Rev 2:26-28. 'And he that overcomes and keeps my words unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations, said Christ, and he shall rule them with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they are broken to shivers, even as I received of my Father, and I will give him the morning star.'

Rev 2:7. 'To him that overcomes will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God.'

Rev 2:10-11. 'And be faithful unto death, and I will give you a crown of life; and he that overcomes shall not be hurt with the second death.'

Rev 3:5. 'And he that overcomes, the same shall be clothed in white raiment, and I will not blot his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels.'

Rev 3:21. 'And him that overcomes will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne.'

Rev 2:17. 'And him that overcomes will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knows, saving he that receives it.'

Rev 3:10. And Christ said, 'you have kept the word of my patience, I will keep you from the hour of temptation, which shall come upon all the world, to try those who dwell upon the earth.'

Rev 3:12. 'And him that overcomes will I make a pillar in the temple of my God, and he shall go no more out, and I will write upon him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God, and I will write upon him my new name.'

Rev 21:7. 'And he that overcomes shall inherit all things, and I will be his God, and he shall be my son.'

But the dragon and the beast, the false prophet and their followers, and the false church that makes war with the lamb and the church of Christ the saints, these say, that there is no overcoming of them while they live upon the earth, but the beast, false prophets, and the whore, and the dragon must have the victory; and the lamb and the saints must not have the victory; and the kingdoms of the world must not become the kingdoms of Christ; this is the beast, and the whore, and the false prophets', and the old dragon's, the devil's, and Satan's false doctrine; but the lamb and the saints shall have the victory over them all.

\*The false church, the followers of the whore and beast today, say that there is no way to be made free of sin; they say perfection is impossible. Because they know they are imperfect and still in sin, they assume no one else could be higher than they are, in their lofty positions, bearing rule by means of their office; this assumption is particularly voiced by the leaders of Christendom who of necessity deny the possibility, for if they admitted it, they would have to resign their paying position and admit to having deceived thousands. Professing to believe in the scriptures, they ignore the hundreds of verses that speak of freedom from sin, perfection, purity, and holiness being required. Professing to believe in Jesus, who gave us so many warnings, requirements, and conditions necessary for salvation; they cast all his teachings behind the backs. In effect, these false prophets, these ministers are dedicated to preserving the beastly nature in man by denying the possibility of overcoming it. They say no one can conquer the beastly nature of sin, proving themselves to ministers of Satan, transformed to appear as ministers of righteousness.

Isaac said, that when Esau had broken Jacob's yoke from off his neck, then Esau should have the dominion, and this Isaac spoke by prophecy, in Gen 27:40, and was fulfilled in Jehoram's days. 2 Chron 21: 4,5,8. For then the Edomites made themselves a king, and this Jehoram compelled Judah to his false worship, and to forsake God's worship. 2 Chron 21:11.

David said, 'O Lord preserve my life from the fear of the enemy, and hide me from the secret council of the wicked, and from the insurrection of the workers

of iniquity, who whet their tongue like a sword, and bend their bows to shoot their arrows, even bitter words.' Psalm 64:2-3.
